Healthcare is an important issue for ALL Arkansans, but many LGBTQ people struggle to find a knowledgeable provider who is sensitive to their needs.

To address this and other concerns, HRC Arkansas is launching Equal Care for Equal Lives, a summit designed for community members, practitioners, and healthcare professionals to build awareness and cultural competency, to leverage best practices, and to gather resources from leading experts and organizations in the field.

Together we are making progress on the road to full equality, yet many LGBTQ Americans still face discrimination in terms of healthcare. Many providers may not know how to serve LGBTQ people. Ultimately, this creates barriers that result in many LGBTQ people not receiving the healthcare they need. By encouraging a broad audience of community members, practitioners, and healthcare professionals, we will create an inclusive healthcare environment for all Arkansans.

Topics that will be presented at the summit include updates on: the prevention and treatment of HIV, LGBTQ health disparities; creating welcoming healthcare spaces; financial barriers to the Affordable Healthcare Act and Medicaid; transgender competency; and discussions on what LGBTQ patients wished their physicians knew.
