An M.D. or D.O. degree, graduation from an ACGME approved anesthesiology residency program, ABA certification or eligibility and a California Medical License are required. National Board of Echocardiography eligibility or certification in Advanced Perioperative Transesophageal Echocardiography is also required. The qualified candidate will have graduated or be graduating from an ACGME accredited adult cardiac anesthesiology fellowship program or have the clinical experience sufficient to meet the requirements for NBE APTE certification. The incumbent will be responsible for the education of residents, fellows and medical students. The successful candidate will be expected to participate in clinical care, teaching, research and university service to varying degrees and participate in the call schedule of the cardiovascular and thoracic anesthesiology section. Candidates will be expected to be committed to or have demonstrated excellence in clinical practice, teaching and research, as evidenced by experience, outcomes and references.
