Position Requirements: MD/DO, California Medical License by date of hire, graduation from an ACGME approved residency program and ABA board certification or eligibility, experience teaching medical students and/or residents and fellows, ability to work cooperatively and collegially within a diverse environment. A critical care fellowship or the equivalent clinical experience is a preferred qualification for one of the positions. The equivalent clinical experience will be determined by the search committee on a case by case basis.
