The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of California, Davis Health System seeks to recruit a full-time, academic Division Director of Maternal Fetal Medicine. The position will be recruited at the Associate or Full Professor level in the Clinical X or Health Sciences Clinical Professor series based on experience and qualifications.

Applicants must possess an MD, MD/PhD or DO from an accredited medical school and have or be eligible to obtain a California Medical License. Applicants must have completed an accredited fellowship and must be board certified in Maternal Fetal Medicine. Applicants must have a minimum of 5 years Post Maternal Fetal Medicine Fellowship experience. Candidate will have the ability to provide clinical care that specializes in high risk care for obstetric patients. The ideal candidate will be a clinical champion and leader in perinatology, especially in fetal conditions. Individuals with specialized interests in prenatal diagnosis and ultrasound are preferred. Candidate will be responsible for teaching students, residents and fellows including non-MFM fellows as a research resource within the department. Research duties will include translational science and/or clinical research that meet the goals of the department. The selected candidate will be expected to participate in clinical care, teaching, research and university service, including such activities with the Maternal Fetal Medicine Fellows. The candidate will have the potential to be an integral part of UCD Health System leadership during the growth of new innovative programs in neonatal intensive care and fetal intervention.

Applicants are required to demonstrate competence in pre-eclampsia/eclampsia, preterm labor, prenatal diagnosis, fetal intervention, ultrasound and genetics, demonstrate clinical skills and judgment, teaching effectiveness and proficiency in clinical investigation. Preferred qualifications include fetal intervention, advanced fetal ultrasonography and MFM Fellowship training program leadership.

University service on committees and tasks force will be as assigned. The candidate will be hired as the Division Director of Maternal Fetal Medicine. The candidate will be expected to provide clinical care and clinical or translational science research to the MFM division. The division currently has individuals focused on perinatal clinical care and education, with an evolving interest in collaborative group trials and outcomes-based research. This candidate is expected to provide mentorship and leadership within clinical, educational, research, and administrative areas.

The candidate must have the ability to work cooperatively and collegially within a diverse environment. Candidate must be able to adhere to policies and procedures. Salary and level of appointment will be based upon experience and qualifications.

For full consideration, applications must be received by March 31, 2017.

The position will remain open until filled through June 30, 2017.
