#### **Health Sciences Assistant/Associate Clinical Professor – Adult Psychiatry Outpatient Clinic and Crisis Stabilization Unit.**

The University of California, Davis, Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences is recruiting for a Health Sciences Assistant/Associate Clinical Professor to serve as a teaching attending in its Adult Outpatient Clinic and Crisis Stabilization Unit. Rank will be dependent on the qualifications of the selected candidate. This position involves supervising general psychiatry residents with their adult cases. In the Crisis Stabilization Unit the incumbent will work with a multi-disciplinary team, including residents and medical students to provide clinical services to a diverse patient population. The candidate will also evaluate and treat their own patients. Qualified candidates must possess an M.D. degree, have experience in teaching and supervising residents and medical students, be Board certified in general psychiatry and have a California Medical license .

The Department of Psychiatry has approximately 55 residents in six residency training programs and 80 faculty and staff psychiatrists and psychologists. The Department provides a stimulating teaching and research environment.
