

Medical Director of Breast Oncology Associate/Full Professor Weill Cornell Medicine

The Division of Hematology and Medical Oncology at Weill Cornell Medicine (WCM), in partnership with NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital and the Meyer Cancer Center, is seeking applicants for a full-time position at the rank of Associate/Full Professor of Medicine to become Medical Director of the Breast Oncology Program. The candidate should be an outstanding clinician, researcher and educator with an international reputation for clinical and translational research in breast cancer. The candidate must have extensive experience in Phase 0-III clinical trials, correlative science and translational studies. A track record of successful funding from federal agencies (e.g., DoD, NIH) and/or supported Investigator Initiated Studies is required. The Medical Director of Breast Oncology will lead the clinical and translational research activities in breast cancer at the Meyer Cancer Center, and practice at the newly established multidisciplinary breast center that includes on site surgery and radiation oncology, located in a state-of-the-art ambulatory David H. Koch building on York Avenue and 69th Street. He/she will interact with a world-class multidisciplinary clinical team and basic science faculty at the medical campus in NYC and at Cornell-Ithaca, and represent WCM at ALLIANCE.
